

6 OLYMPIAD and AWARD POLICY

We encourage all TEACHERS to prepare students for various Olympiads that occur throughout the year meant to widen their knowledge and to gain meaningful experiences and practice the subject matter outside their curriculum. Some of the Olympiads our students are required to participate in are:

- All subject Olympiads in district (first round participation) is COMPULSORY.
- All subject Olympiads in city.
- All National Olympiads in Ukraine.
- MAN Project competition.
- Other International Olympiads and Project Competitions.

6.1 Student selection process and conditions

- A student can only participate in two Olympiads and one project competition per year.
- The winnings are ONLY for students who are regularly attending trainings provided by the school; students are allowed only FIVE unexcused absences for each subject.
- Trainings will be scheduled after school hours (16:45) or during weekends.
- Trainings will be free of charge for MIS students.
- The awards for success in local Olympiads (municipality, region, country) are distributed according to school's administration in such way:
- Olympiad trial exams should be done once a month.

6.2 Olympiad Awards

The awards for success in local Olympiads (municipality, region, country) are distributed according to school's administration as follows:

6.3 The Obligations of Olympiad Participants

1. Follow all inner-school rules:
 - a. The time when student is free of lesson due to Olympiad preparation, means he/she has to be in preparation classroom, should wear descent/appropriate clothes;
 - b. Students are not allowed to bring forbidden things according to school's rules.
 - c. The student/participant of Olympiad has to follow everything considered with compulsory lessons according to timetable.
2. The involvement of student/participant in out-of-class meetings is discussed accordingly between class teacher and Olympiad's vice principal.
3. The administration does not provide a guarantee that each student chosen for Olympiad preparation will end gaining possibility of participation in Olympiad itself. However, the student's achievements will define the next steps.
4. The school retains the medal and a copy of certificate which were given to the student, while he/she keeps the original certificate.
